WHAT TO WEAR TO YOUR FALL FAMILY 2024 PHOTO SESSION

Remember that this session will be outdoor and I highly recommend to consider the weather at the time you decide on your family outfits.

Here are a few wardrobe tips to help you look stylish.

- Basics - Wear colors that flatter your skin and hair, as well as choosing colors that coordinate with your family without being overly matchy.
- Colors - A trick to keep in mind is to think about the setup. (Pictures are attached below)
- Body type - Dress for your body type. I find that flowy, yet fitted fabrics look fantastic. Don't be afraid to accentuate your shape - this goes for men as well! When buying outfits for your children, always choose well-fit clothing instead of something they can grow into later. Show off your favorite part of your body and you'll end up feeling confident!
- Shoes - You must consider that your shoes will be shown, so try to match them with your outfit. The majority of the farm is grass or loose clay and can be difficult to walk in, so take it into consideration when you choose your shoes.
- Comfort - Never wear something that makes you feel uncomfortable or unsure.
- Stylish - My last tip, and most important. Dress extra special! Yes, it's that simple. I, personally, love jeggings and sweaters. They're comfortable. But if I'm spending time, energy, and money on a photo session for my family - I'm going to take the time to pick out something special for each family member. I'm going to pick an outfit that takes me a step up from the every day. But I'm not going to stop there. I'm going to think about jewelry, shoes, and other accessories that will really make my outfit look complete. (Hats are a great idea for this setup)
