Important Information About Your Session Date:

- Christmas Mini Sessions will be held in my home studio located at 1295 Drake Ridge Drive, Kissimmee, FL 34744.
- Mini-Sessions run on a strict schedule, so please plan to arrive at least 10-15 minutes early. If you are not on time, the photographer will need to attend to the next family in the itinerary.
- Make sure your kids have eaten and had plenty of rest to ensure they're in a happy mood for their photos!
- This is a "Two-in-One" session. We will have a formal, beautiful Christmas setup ready, but you can also bring your pajamas for a more cozy and relaxed session on the bed. (Yes, cookies and milk are also included!).
- Your family will have some time in between to change into your pajamas. However, please come dressed and ready for the formal setup.
- Proofing galleries will be sent 7 days after the session, and your edited selections will be ready 7 days following that.
- Pets are not allowed during this session. I'm sorry for any inconvenience!

Payment:

- To ensure a smooth and timely experience, the **remaining balance must be paid in full** before your session.
- You will receive your invoice the same day as your session (early in the morning), and the payment must be completed before arriving at the studio.
- Payments can only be made through the invoice.

What to Wear to Your Christmas 2025 Photo Session

This session will feature two different setups one formal or casual and the other on the bed (pajamas). I've attached photos below so you can get an idea of how the setups will look.

Here are some wardrobe tips to help you look stylish:

Basics: Wear colors that flatter your skin and hair. Also, choose colors that coordinate with your family, but avoid being too matchy.

Colors: Consider the setup when choosing your colors. A good trick is to think about the tones in the background and ensure your clothing complements them.

Body Type: Dress for your body type. Flowy yet fitted fabrics look fantastic on everyone. Don't be afraid to accentuate your shape it works for men too! When buying outfits for children, always choose clothes that fit them now, rather than something they will grow into. Confidence comes from wearing clothes that fit well and make you feel great!

Shoes: Your shoes will be visible in the formal or casual setup, so make sure they match your outfit. For the bed session, only socks are required!

Comfort: Never wear something uncomfortable. If you love maxi dresses, wear one! If your husband prefers a button-up shirt with the sleeves rolled up instead of a blazer, he'll look great in his photos.

Stylish: Dress a little extra special! I personally love jeggings and sweaters—they're comfortable. But if I'm spending time, energy, and money on a photo session for my family, I want to make sure everyone looks their best. Think about what makes your family stand out, from clothing to accessories like jewelry and shoes, and make sure everything is well-coordinated.
